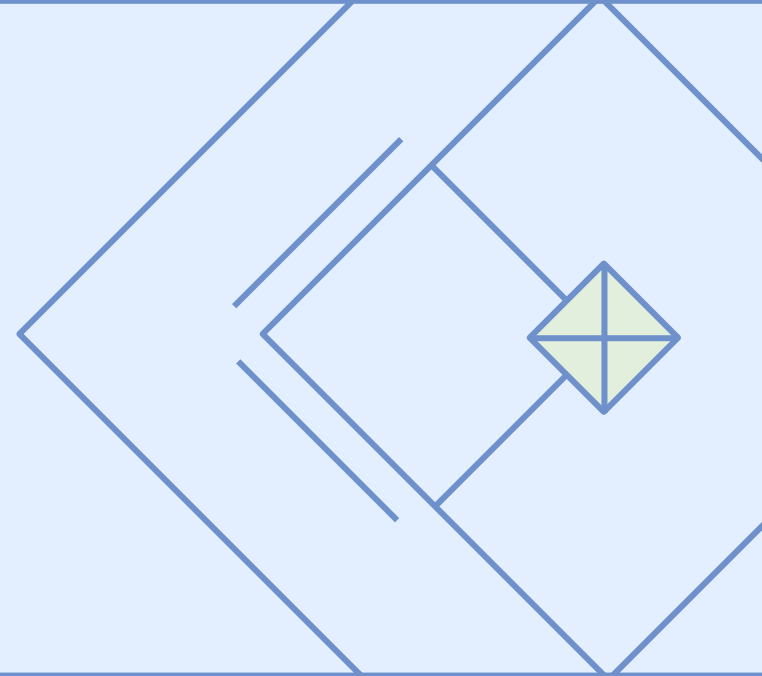






# GOOGLE CLASSROOM

## ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL MEMBERS

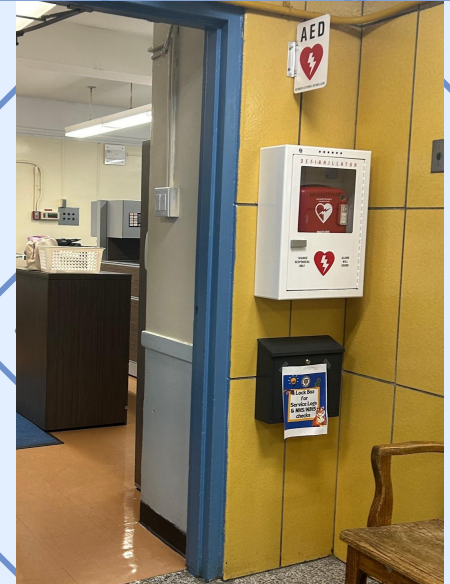
- 90 or greater on Term Grades

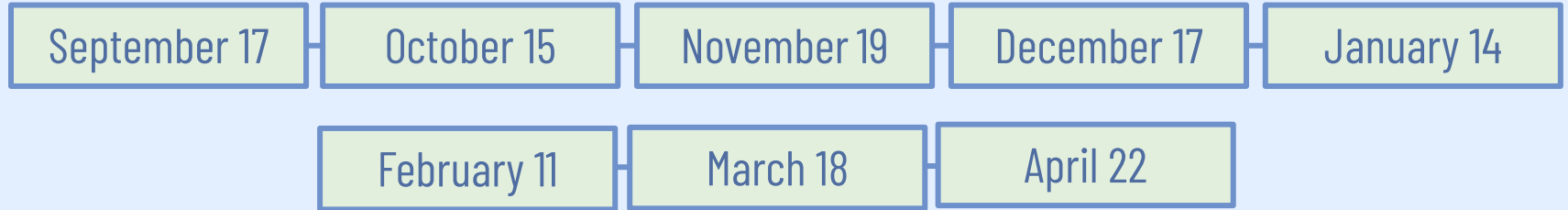

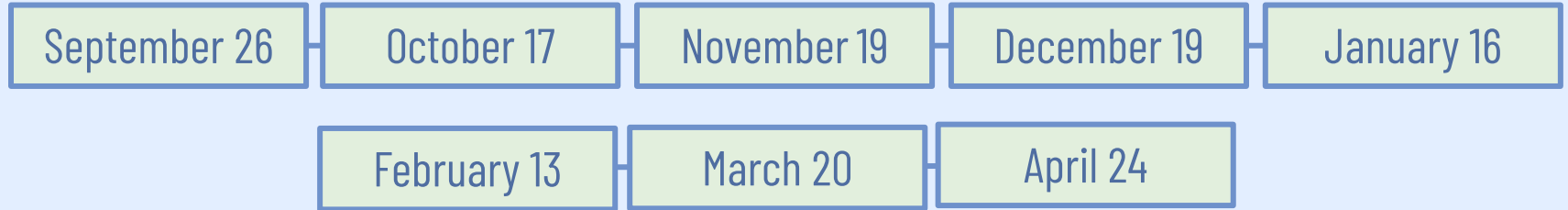

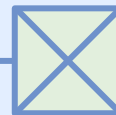

We want 8 tigers to help out**



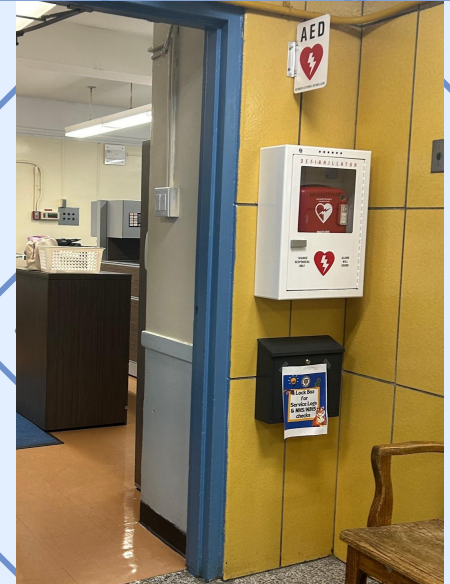


