

National Honor Society / National Junior Honor Society		
Requirements for Induction- SY 24-25		
Students will be invited to join the Honor Society based on the following criteria. Students must pay the dues and complete the other requirements before induction.		
All hours and dues for continuing members are due 4/24/25		
The following students are continuing members who will be included in NJHS/NHS for the '24-25 school year.		
Class of '29, '26, '25		
Members whose GPA falls below the minimum are considered "not in good standing" and may not participate in the trip or other recognition activities.		
The following students will be invited to apply in Spring '25 and join based on this criteria:		
Students in current grade 7 (Class of '30)- 90% cumulative GPA for both 6th grade terms, and term 1 of their 7th grade year and students in current grade 10 - 90% cumulative for both 9th grade terms and term 1 of their 10th grade year.		
Special Circumstances		
Members whose GPA falls below the minimum are considered "not in good standing" and may not participate in the trip or other recognition activities		
New admits to RKA in Grades 8, 11, and 12 will be evaluated after one term in RKA. Cumulative GPA must 90% or greater.		
After being invited, the following requirements must be met to be inducted:		
Students must have a good record of Scholarship, Service, Leadership, and Character. Infractions indicating that the student does not possess these characteristics will prevent a person from being inducted. Infractions include but are not limited to theft, plagiarism, dishonesty, bullying, harassment, violence, weapons, and/or drugs.		
For induction into the National Honor Society and National Junior Honor Society in school year 2024-25, every Honor Society candidate must complete 10 hours of community service outside the school, or working with Team Tiger or participate in other school organized volunteer functions. Community Service hours will be verified and tallied and shared with students in the NJHS/NHS GC in Jan '25 and April '25. Final points/hours tabulation will take place at the end of April. Points will then be verified and official Invites will be sent by the first week in May.		
Meetings:		
NHS meetings take place after school typically on the third Tuesday of the month in Sept, Oct, Nov, Dec, Jan, Feb, March, April for a total of 8. Students must attend and participate in 6 of the 8 meetings.		
NJHS meetings take place period 8 on the third Thursday of the month in Sept, Oct, Nov, Dec, Jan, Feb, March, April for a total of 8. Students must attend and participate in 6 of the 8 meetings.		
Meetings will be led by the NHS and NJHS officers and the Advisors		
During meetings Officers propose a service activity or a drive (AKA "in-service project") in meeting and looks for ideas from the group. The general membership offers input on school community service projects and signs up to help with the projects.		
Drive or service events ("in service project") occur 3 times a year- Oct/Nov/Dec, Jan/Feb and March/April. All members must assist in one of the service activities or drives in addition to earning 10 community points. Members should plan ahead to make sure they can participate in one of the events.		
Officers and Advisor will meet at a separate time to investigate causes, plan trip and plan ceremony.		
Recognition		
All first time inductees will be invited to an Induction Ceremony in the Spring. The NHS/ NJHS Induction Ceremony will be in mid to late May.		
Members in good standing are invited to the Honor Society Trip tentatively scheduled for mid to late May		
Only Seniors who have been in National Honor Society for Grades 10-12 and are in good standing will wear the stole at graduation.		
Only 8th graders who have been in National Junior Honor Society for Grades 7 and 8 and are in good standing will wear the stole at graduation
